
As part of a weekend high performance driver education (HPDE) event, the Alabama Region of the Porsche Club of America (ALPCA) has developed an introductory experience to driving your sports car on the track.

The experience is called DEX and here is a description:

*Designed for first timers who have never driven their car on a track.

*Drivers must be 18 years of age.

*Provides a safe and educational experience to driving on the track.

*Combines both classroom and in car instruction.

*Takes place in one day on the Saturday of a HPDE weekend.

*Your weekend schedule will look something like this and will include:

+Registration and car inspection by ALPCA on Friday evening open from 5:30 to 8:00 pm, or on Saturday at 6:00 to 7:00 AM.

+Driver's meeting at 7:00 AM on Saturday.

+First class room morning session taught by an experienced ALPCA instructor.

+On the track as a passenger in your assigned instructor's car being driven at safe speeds.

+He/she will point out the correct driving line, corner worker stations, and landmarks to help you visualize the line.

+A second classroom session in the afternoon.

+You then driving your car on the track with your same instructor at safe speeds.

+Debriefing and wrap up with any questions.

*Registration, waiver signature, and payment is made by establishing your personal account profile on Clubregistration.net.

*The cost is \$100 for the day and includes an event T-Shirt. Note that we run rain or shine unless the track is closed for weather threats.

*NOTE: DEX drivers do not have to have their cars third party tech inspected and you do not need a helmet.
