IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PORSCHES & PLANES. MUST READ

Greetings Friends,

Here are some important final details and attachments for Porsches & Planes 9/14/24. Please read to the end. Very important information follows. Forward this to all your registered guests.

The event runs from 11 am through 4 pm. Try to arrive by 12:30.

Code 1 Aviation 1601 Grumman Dr. Rockford, IL 61109. Google Maps is accurate.

Expect to have a lot of fun and see some special things. Check out all the interesting stuff in the hangar. Watch the fighter pilot videos on the big screen. Hop in the cockpit of a jet fighter for some photos.

Code 1 Aviation staff will be identifiable by their T-shirts and will be very happy to answer any questions you may have. Stay for the door prize awards around 2:30 pm, and the raffle drawing around 3:30 pm. Wear your club name tag and make new friends.

There are three attached items. One is an overhead showing the general event layout. The second, "PRE", should be printed, or displayed on your phone, and shown to the greeter as you approach the Code 1 Aviation parking lot. It indicates you have pre-registered. If you have registered guests arriving separately, provide them with a copy to use. The third item is this same announcement.

Porsches only are allowed to park on the tarmac. The greeter will point you to the entrance drive. We are planning an epic aerial Porsches & Planes group photo, so we are trying to arrange cars for it. You will be asked if you will remain for the group photo set for 3 pm. If not, you will be pointed to the short-term parking area nearby, still on the tarmac. Non-Porsches will be directed by the greeter to the regular exterior parking lot.

After you park, find the registration table inside the hangar. There you MUST check in, and you and all your guests will sign the required PCA standard waivers. Parents must sign waivers for all people under 18. ALL people will be given and must wear a wristband to satisfy the security protocol for this event.

Registered people can pick up a bag of swag (except children under 12) and t-shirt after you check in. Swag and t-shirts are limited supply and we may run out. Pick up any raffle tickets you purchased when you pre-registered. (Hey, buy a bunch more while you are standing there. We have great gifts in support of a great cause. We can take cash or credit cards!)

The Pizza food truck arrives around noon. The Taco truck comes about 2 pm.

The Color Guard will post colors at 1 pm. We will have some brief comments from our very special guest, Major General John L. Borling, USAF, Retired, who is a local resident and friend of Code 1 Aviation (Please Google him).

Extremely important: This event is being held within the Airside Security Restricted Area, as authorized by the airport authority and the TSA. Compliance with special event rules is therefore mandatory. Our tarmac parking area and event boundary is defined by the ring of aircraft you will see parked outside the hangar. DO NOT PROCEED BEYOND THIS BOUNDRY! The boundary is depicted by the red and white stripes in the overhead photo for your information, however there are no red and white stripes painted on the tarmac itself, so remain within the ring of planes. Always keep track of your children! Active aircraft exist beyond the boundary. Airports are serious about security. If you violate these simple rules, you will be forced to leave the event. When you depart, exit through the indicated drive immediately east of the entrance drive. Do not attempt to drive onto taxiways or runways. If you do your life will become very complicated.
