Race & Track Specific Information

The Rules for Club Racing are in effect as soon as you arrive at the track.

Stewards: Vicki Earnshaw (Mobile 720-244-1532) and Bruce Boeder

Contact with your Stewards should be via email: summit@pcaclubracing.org, This email goes directly to the Stewards and will be monitored during the event by the Stewards or Stewards assistant. Please do not visit the tower unless you are bringing video or have been invited.

The Stewards will text updates and other information to the participants. If you have not signed up for PCA texting, go to ClubRegistration.net and sign up.

The PCA Radio channel for the Stewards to communicate to teams: **464.8250 MHz 251 DPL**.

Scrutineers: Your event Scrutineers are Brian Gay, Lori Schutz, Lisa Parker, and Dale Tuety.

Scrutineers will be at black flag on the hot pit lane during on-track sessions. They will be at Tech or in the paddock when we are not running. Look for the blue PCA shirts for assistance or questions. You may text them at:

Your Scrut(s) may be electronically collecting data to measure gearing, turbo boost, HP, seconds over spec RPM's, etc. We choose cars on a random and non-random basis.

Timing & Scoring: David Anderson and TJ Gottwalt

David and TJ will be in Timing Building. Change request forms, for example adding an Enduro co-driver, will be done through Registration located in the Race Headquarters Tent. There is no need to come to Timing unless you are invited or have a need to be there, such as an issue with your transponder.

Driver Registration and Tech: All drivers must be pre-registered at ClubRegistration.net. Registered drivers are required to complete on-line PCA waivers prior to the event. All drivers must bring identification to Registration in the Race HQ Tent. We will be back to a full paper tech at this event, so all drivers must then bring logbook to Tech located in the Tech Shed to complete registration and receive tech sticker to be displayed on your car. Racers with cars with existing PCA Club Racing logbooks should insert completed 2024 Compliance forms in their logbooks and also complete a page in their logbook for the Summit Point Club Race. For racers with cars that do not have a logbook, or their logbooks updated or whose safety gear needs inspection, they should bring their cars, equipment, and Tech paperwork to Tech in the Tech Shed.

Check to be sure you have your run group sticker, helmet sticker, and roll bar tech sticker properly displayed. Wrist band designating your race registration should be worn and shown at grid.

Drivers Meetings: There is a MANDATORY Drivers Meeting Friday at 8:15 am in Race HQ Tent. There is an OPTIONAL Drivers Q&A on Saturday @ 7:45 am, also in the Race HQ Tent

Blend Line: When entering the track from the pits: Stay right until you have passed the *second* cross road (a paved area).

Be Aware: Entering the track down the main straight could find the cars on track at high speed because of the length of the straight. A dip in the track could limit their vision of your entry. It will be the responsibility of the driver entering the track to make a Safe entry. Those who move over before the second access road will receive the same penalty as for a pass under yellow, with the same 30 minute window to bring your video to the stewards.

Rules Reminders:

- **Passing Under Yellow:** Look at the white board at the Black Flag station in the hot pits after the checker. If your number is listed on the board, you have been observed passing under yellow. You have 30 minutes to dispute that call by providing video to your Steward.

- **Car to Car Incident Procedures**

If you are involved in an incident, you have the option to determine if it is safe to continue. However, you are required to report to Black Flag at the end of your session. For car-to-car incidents (or any other video you need to share with the steward) bring your video of the incident to the Steward on a SD Card or thumb drive with your car number written on it along with a Drivers Incident Report. You will be required to leave the video with the Stewards assistant so bring extra, just in case.

Checkered Flag: Front straight for all sessions.

Pit Speed Limit: 35 MPH

Black Flags: Turn #7 and start/finish.

Black Flag Station: On the right side as you exit the track at the end of the hot pit lane. This is the location of the Scrutineers. Always look for instructions/information as you exit the track.

Timing Loop: Directly under the Start/Finish stand and is marked clearly. The Start/Finish timing loop does not cover the hot pits so you cannot take the checkered flag in the pits.

Enduro Pit Timing Loops: Are located at Pit Entry and Pit Exit, clearly marked with GREEN cones.

Scales: Scales are located at Tech and are open most of the day.

Impound: At Tech.

Sound Limit: 103 db. The sound level meter is on the left side of the track $\frac{3}{4}$ way down the main straight.

Medical Location: The ambulance in the EMS lot near Pit Out

Result Sheets: Timing sheets will be available at the Race HQ Tent. Check results to confirm your transponder is working and your information is correct.

Enduro Pits Closed Sign: Turn 7

Race Fuel: Race fuel is available at the track; 93 & 100 octane (unleaded ethanol) and 110 octane (leaded).

Local Information

Paddock direction is clockwise ALWAYS for EVERYONE. Paddock speed limit is 10 mph.

All rental equipment must be removed from the premises by 6 PM on Sunday

No motorized track access after the track goes cold and no access at all after dark.

Quiet Time: No “race engines” or other loud vehicles may be run either on track, in the paddock, or in any area of the facility before 7:00 AM or after 7:00 PM.

Your Weekend Sessions

Your Points Races are all three races.

Grid Position for each session:

Practice 1: first come first served

Practice 2: best time from Practice 1

Qualifying: best time from Practice 2

Sprint 1: best time from Qualifying

Sprint 2: best time from Sprint 1

Enduro: best time from Sprint 1 or Sprint 2

Calls to Grid: 1st@15min, 2nd@10min, Grid closes at 5min. Get to grid early.

Qualifying

Qualifying session is your third session and is on your schedule as “Qualifying” Your qualifying session will be on the clock, so the number of laps is as time allows.

Sprint Races

Length of the sprint races is scheduled to be 30 minutes from green flag to checker, but Race to the Checkered flag.

Enduro Races

Length of enduro races is 90 minutes, fueling allowed. There is a mandatory 5-minute pit stop

The Enduro Races will be run under the **Enduro protocols.**

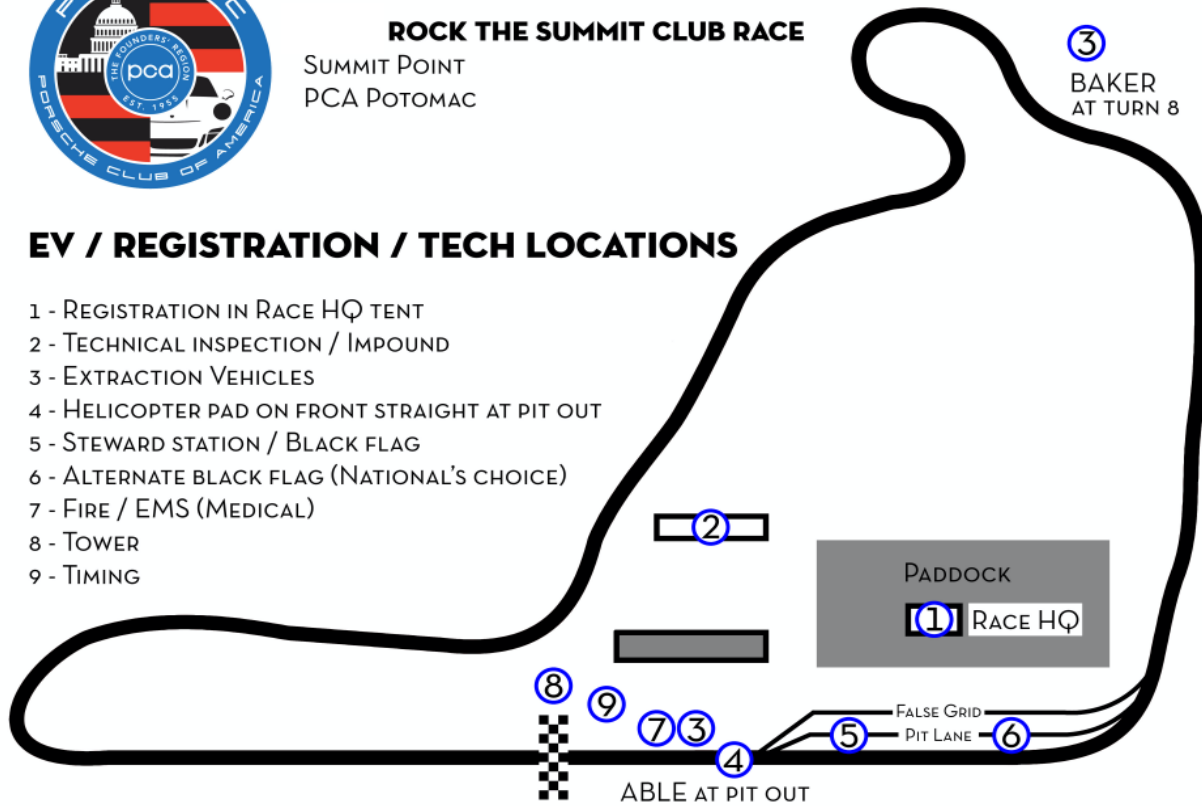

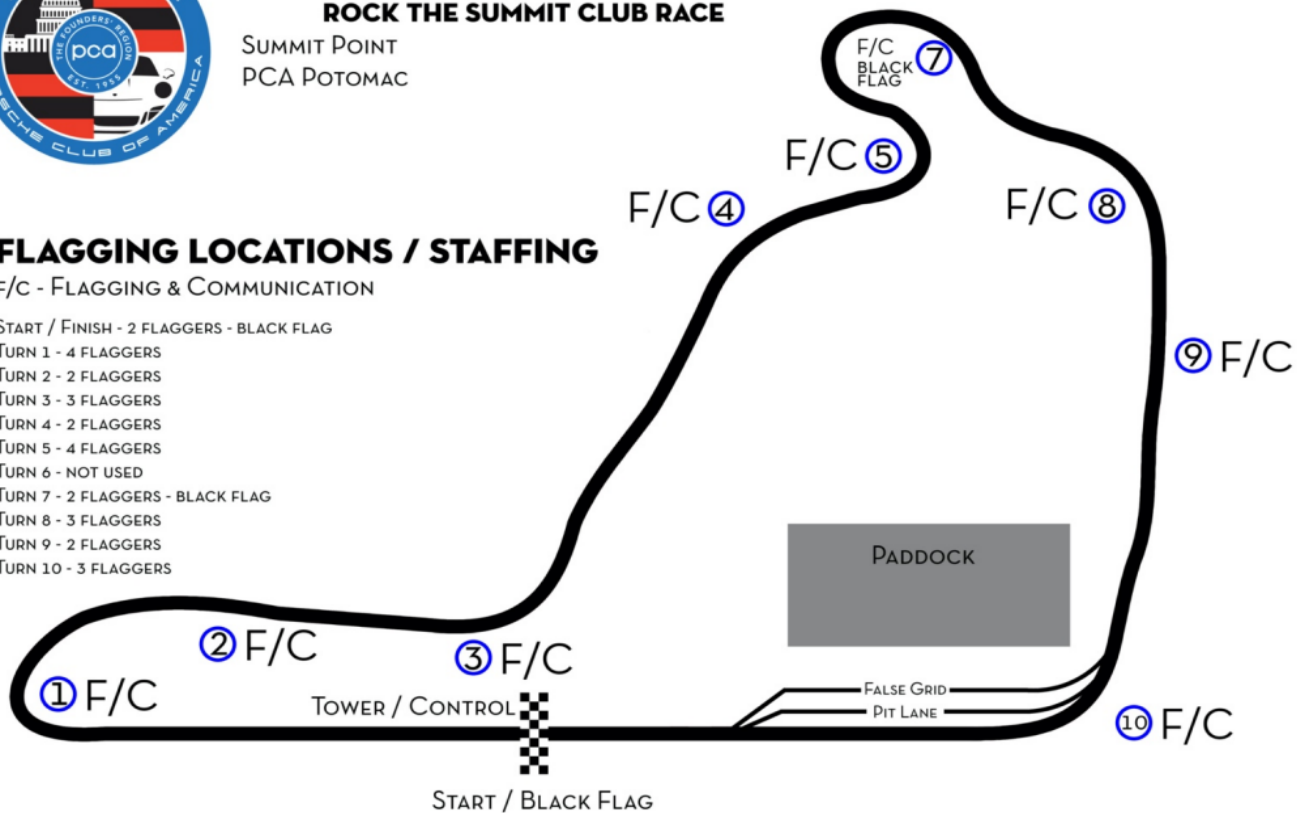
