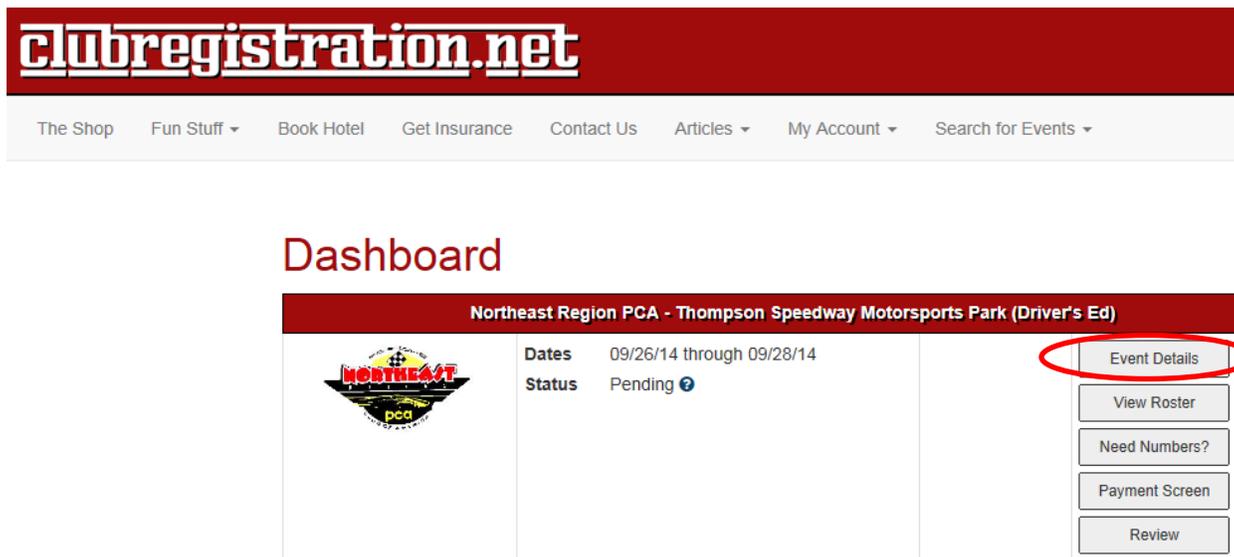


Contacting your instructor/student

How to contact your assigned instructor or student before a Driver Education Event

This is for both student and Instructors, so Instructors, please read to the end.

So it is getting close to the Driver Education event that you have been looking forward to and you are a student and would like to know how to contact your instructor. First you need to log into ClubRegistration.net using the same username and password that you used to first sign up for the event. When you log in, you will be greeted by a page similar to the one below. Now click the "Event Details" button (circled in red below) for the event.

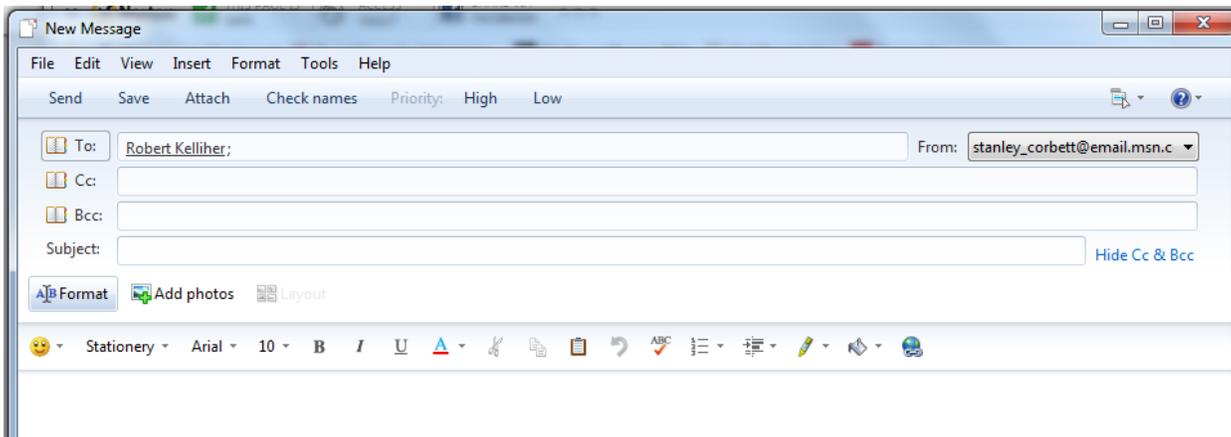
